I am pleased to share with you Friends of Ngong Road's 2022 Annual Report. Last year was one of expanded opportunities, for both the active students in our program and the alumni.

Elimu Hub, our solar-powered learning center, is constructed of six shipping containers and houses a computer lab and library. The vibrant hub welcomes 250 students per term who benefit from computer class, study time, or discovering a new book.

We now have a full time Employment Officer dedicated to supporting our alumni in obtaining job skills, specialized training, and stable employment. Our alumni have access to Entrepreneurship Training, Computer Certifications, gig employment in our TechMates lab, and job search support. The alumni formed a Self Help Group to enhance mentorship and interpersonal skills development. You'll read here what five alumni share about their career goals and life transformation.

Your support of Friends of Ngong Road has resulted in the increased capacity of infrastructure and human resources in Nairobi. We raised the most money in our 17 year history in 2022, and we are focused on our strategic goal of doubling the number of students served by 2026.

The encouragement, opportunity, and inclusion that surrounds our students and alumni is an embodiment of our "Wepowerment" value. Together, we create a culture of high expectations and self-determination that buoys the students as they transform their lives through education and support, leading to employment.

The increased capacity in 2022 created the staff and resources we need in order to double the number of students in the program. Looking ahead, we will offer new strategies to support life transformation:

- Our students will benefit from increased program support for tech training, art therapy, book group, and chess clubs in the Elimu Hub.
- Our alumni will be able to utilize the expansion of Entrepreneurship and Apprenticeship Training, opportunities for tech training and paid work, in addition to job seeking and mentorship support.
- Our Scholarship Fund creates opportunities for new students to enroll in our program without having a 1:1 sponsor.
- Our planned giving and endowed scholarship programs offer individual or family donors an opportunity to create a legacy of education for years to come.


