Sample Itinerary

Day 1: Welcome to Nairobi

Your guide will meet you in the evening at the Jomo Kenyatta International Airport in Nairobi. From the airport, you'll ride to your Nairobi lodging, where you will meet your fellow adventurers and gather for a trip briefing before retiring to a night of rest.

Accommodation: DoubleTree by Hilton

Day 2: Fly from Nairobi to the Maasai Mara for your first game drive

After breakfast, you'll fly to Kenya's famous game reserve. The Mara is one of the richest wildlife game reserves and home to the black-maned lion, the elusive leopard, stately giraffes, vast herds of elephants, rhinos, thundering herds of zebra, and migrating wildebeest. After lunch in camp, you'll enjoy an afternoon game drive.

Day 3: Enjoy a full day in the Maasai Mara

You'll spend the day exploring the Maasai Mara Reserve. Located in the Great Rift Valley, the reserve is primarily open grassland and regarded as the jewel of Kenya's wildlife viewing areas. There have been some 95 species of mammals, amphibians, and reptiles, and over 400 bird species recorded on the reserve. Nowhere in Africa is wildlife more abundant, and it is for this reason that a visitor hardly misses seeing the big five - buffalo, elephant, leopard, lion, and rhino.

A hot air balloon safari is an optional treat at dawn if you'd like to elevate your experience–literally. Take the opportunity to fly over the Mara in a Hot Air Balloon, provided to you at an additional cost of \$520. The balloon package includes a champagne breakfast in the wild! Alternatively, visit a Maasai village and learn about the Maasai culture at no extra cost.

Day 4: Search for elephants, hippos, buffalo, and more in Amboseli National Park.

After breakfast, you'll transfer to Ol Kiombo airstrip for your flight to Amboseli. After lodge check-in, enjoy an afternoon game drive around this panoramic yet compact park, which is dotted with emerald green swamps in which great herds of elephant wallow half-submerged in the papyrus grasses. These permanent marshlands also provide a potent draw for hippos and buffalo, while offering a haven for the abundant water birds.

<u>Accommodation</u>: Ol Tukai Lodge, Amboseli

Day 5: Full day in Amboseli National Park.

You'll spend the full day game-driving in the park, which is an International Biosphere Reserve featuring the dried-out lakebed of prehistoric Lake Amboseli, rolling savannah, and lush green swamps. The plains offer numerous antelopes, spotted hyenas, jackals, warthogs, olive baboons, vervet monkeys, and the chance of spotting a lion, leopard, or cheetah. Observation Hill, a conical peak that is easily climbed, offers stunning views of Mount Kilimanjaro.

Day 6: Take in final views before heading back to Nairobi.

Day 9: Elephant Orphanage, Giraffe Centre, Kazuri and Utamaduni

After an early breakfast, spend your last morning in Kenya with a game drive in Nairobi National Park. As the only national park in the world that is situated so close to a capital city, you'll be excited to view lions, giraffes, rhinos, zebras, and over 400 species of birds.

You'll visit Sheldrick Wildlife Trust's Elephant Orphanage to learn about their conservation work and meet the elephants in their care. You'll move on to the Giraffe Centre, where you can interact with endangered Rothschild Giraffes that are being captively raised to conserve the species.

You'll finish the day visiting the Kobe bead factory and Utamaduni for traditional crafts shopping. The workshop serves as a platform for single mothers, widows, and orphans, providing them with fair wages and opportunities to develop their artistic skills. In the evening, you'll transfer to the airport for your flight home.
